

The Arc, Ocean County Chapter's mission is to advocate, provide opportunities and supports necessary for all individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to be accepted and valued as citizens of the community in which they choose to live, learn, work and play.

The Arc, Ocean County Chapter provides residential, vocational, family support, and recreation services to 1,500 individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families.

- \$2 per pay period (\$52) provides one hour of Employment Support Services
- \$5 per pay period (\$130) provides 600 miles of transportation to Day Programs
- \$13 per pay period (\$338) provides one day of Residential Direct Care
