

The Epilepsy Foundation trains more than 1,000 nurses, teachers and first responders in seizure recognition and first aid each year.

The Epilepsy Foundation invests over 1 million dollars in epilepsy research each year.

- \$5 per pay period (x 26 paychecks = \$130) provides travel expenses for a person living with epilepsy and their family who must travel more than 50 miles from their home to receive FDAapproved medical care and/or treatment for their epilepsy/seizure disorder but lack adequate financial resources.
- \$10 per pay period (x 26 paychecks = \$260) provides information and support to newly diagnosed people with epilepsy.
- \$25 per pay period (x 26 paychecks = \$650) provides seizure first aid training certifications for 50 people.
